## Parent/Player Contract 2009-2010

Legion Volleyball Club shall provide an opportunity for girls to develop their individual and team volleyball skills. Players shall have the opportunity to play alongside players of similar ability. Players shall have the opportunity to compete at the highest possible level. Legion Volleyball is affiliated with the Garden Empire Volleyball Association of USA Volleyball, and offers opportunities to play through practices, scrimmages, and travel tournaments. Each player must follow the USAV Code of Conduct and is expected to adhere to the following Legion Volleyball policies. The ultimate goal of the program is to develop players into successful volleyball players. Wins and losses are never a consistent measure of performance and not of primary concern.

### Player Guidelines

**Attendance** – It is the responsibility of the player to notify the coach of scheduled events that the player will be missing.

**Arriving on Time** – players are expected to arrive to practice 15 minutes prior to the scheduled practice time.

**Practices** – players must give notification of their absence at least 48 hours in advance of the scheduled practice, unless there is an illness or an unforeseen emergency.

**Tournaments** – players or parents must give notification within 2 weeks of the scheduled tournament, unless there is an illness or unforeseen emergency.

Tardiness is disrespectful to those who have made the effort to be on time.

### Player Conduct

- ✓ Equal playing time is NOT guaranteed, though all efforts will be made during tournament pool play to give players as much game experience as possible. During playoffs, players who provide the best opportunity to progress within the tournament will be given the opportunity to succeed. Coaches have the responsibility of evaluating players during each practice and during tournaments. Playing time is earned! It is expected that each player give their full commitment and 100% of their effort to their team. Failure to do so could result in less playing time. If there is a question about playing time, the player is to set up a meeting time with their coach and a parent.
- ✓ Players must be “coachable” and willing to make adjustments in technique and decision making.
- ✓ Players are expected to hustle at all times during practice and at tournaments.
- ✓ The Legion Volleyball Club will NOT tolerate foul language or rude gestures towards other players, parents, coaches, officials or opponents.
- ✓ Cell phones are to be off and put away during practice. Phones may be used for emergencies only.
- ✓ During tournament events, players are encouraged to sit together and scout opponents. Coaches will provide scouting sheets and specific responsibilities.
- ✓ During tournaments, players are required to “work” and will be responsible for officiating, scorekeeping and calling lines. All athletes are required to attend the SRVA Scorekeeping and Officiating clinic that the GEVA USA Volleyball region provides. No player is permitted to leave a tournament site until all responsibilities are completed, unless instructed by their coach.

- ✓ Players are expected to be supportive of their teammates on the court and while on the bench. Poor conduct could result in reduced playing time.

## **Zero Tolerance**

The Legion Volleyball Club practices a zero tolerance policy. Any player who is caught with drugs or alcohol, or behaving in any immoral, illicit, or illegal manner during any club event will be dismissed from the Club.

## **Parent Guidelines and Conduct**

- ✓ It is the responsibility of the parents to understand and adhere to the attendance policy under the player guidelines.
- ✓ All parents are expected to conduct themselves in a positive fashion while their athlete is participating in the Legion Volleyball Club program. Parents are invited to attend all practices and tournaments, and are asked to be positive while in that environment. Parents that cannot follow these rules could be asked to leave the gym during all practices and competitions.
- ✓ No non-Coach parent is allowed to coach or attempt to coach their athlete during any practice or tournament nor are parents allowed to be on the gym floor during tournaments unless requested.
- ✓ At tournaments, parents are expected to inform the coach when their child is leaving the tournament facility. If players are to leave the facility with anyone other than their parent, permission for the coaches to release the players from the site needs to be provided in writing.
- ✓ Parents may not discuss player/team performance topics before, during or after any practice or tournament play.
- ✓ During tournaments, parents are asked to be respectful of players, coaches, officials and the working team. Any negative comments will not be tolerated. If there is a concern, parents should not approach the coach about the concern; parents should request to set up a meeting with Coach Roman in which the concern can be addressed.
